# **Memorial Garden – Vision to Reality**

On May 30, over 200 community members attended the Memorial Garden dedication at Lake Park's West Campus. The memorial garden idea originated with students who wanted to honor the memory of a classmate who passed away during the 2013-14 school year. Working with the school's two principals, the idea of creating a permanent memorial garden was brought to the Lake Park Educational Foundation who agreed to take a leadership role in bringing this idea to fruition. Working with students, staff, community members, and the school's architectural firm, ARCON Associates, Inc., who donated the design plans for the garden, the Foundation began a year-long fund-raising campaign that raised over \$30,000 to support the building of the Memorial Garden. A great deal of thanks goes to the District's maintenance staff who provided the labor to construct the garden resulting in a savings of \$10,000.

The garden provides students, families, and friends of Lake Park with a peaceful setting for solace and remembrance. Commemorative bricks for the walkway surrounding the Memorial Garden may still be purchased by contacting the Foundation.

# Funds for Excellence Grants: \$17,494

Today, schools face the challenge of using their limited resources to meet the growing needs of students while maintaining outstanding curricular opportunities. This is where the Foundation's Funds for Excellence program steps in by supporting

innovative projects that stretch beyond the regular school district budget to reach all students. This year, the Foundation awarded teacher-developed grants, such things as tablet computers for use in math and business classes, Smart Music software and an iPad for the Music Program, Activity Trackers to help teachers increase student achievement, a large format printer for the Art Department, and to purchase books for students and a guest speaker to support the school's antibullying initiative. The Foundation also supported sending students to the Rotary Youth Leadership Conference and made a subsequent commitment to continue this effort in the future. Over the past four years, the Foundation has awarded over \$57,800 in grants to directly aid teachers and students.

## Foundation Board Members Volunteer at Northern Illinois Food Bank





In an effort to reach out to those in need and to provide community support, members of the Lake Park Foundation Board and volunteers assisted at the Northern Illinois Food Bank on two occasions. Through their efforts, they were able to provide food for 8,973 meals for needy families.

# **Emergency Need and Support Fund: \$4,016**

The Emergency Need and Support Fund provides assistance for school-related expenses for Lake Park students in financial need. The Fund also provides free breakfast and lunch coupons for students whose families are facing financial challenges but do not qualify for the federal free/reduced lunch program.

Since 2012, the Emergency Need and Support Fund has provided over \$8,430 in assistance to help over 550 Lake Park students achieve academic success and experience personal well-being.

The Emergency Need and Support Fund also exemplifies a goal of the Foundation to promote student development by assisting students in need with field trip, ACT prep class, and Advanced Placement exam costs. Two recent thank you notes from students illustrate the impact of the program:

"I just wanted to thank you for helping fund my AP exams and the ACT prep class. Your generous assistance has encouraged me to take greater leaps and given me reassurance that socio-economic backgrounds do not reflect a person's ability to achieve. I thank you so much and hope to one day do what you are doing by helping those who have ambitions and the persistence to attain those ambitions."

# College Scholarships: \$21,500

This year the Foundation awarded 25 scholarships to help students pursuing their education after graduation from high school. Since 2010 alone, the Foundation has awarded 102 scholarships totaling \$90,100. Individuals can donate directly to one of the Foundation scholarships, or they can create an annual scholarship in honor or memory of a loved one that the Foundation would publicize, administer, and work with the donor to determine selection criteria. The benefit of the Foundation's scholarship program may best be expressed by two recent scholarship recipients:


